Information You Provide to Us

We collect personal information you provide to us, for example when you use our Site, purchase products or services from us, request information from us, contact customer support, or otherwise communicate with us. Personal information, personal data or PII means any

Google Analytics

Information Collected Through Cookies and Similar Technologies

We and our service providers use cookies, web beacons, and other technologies to receive and store certain types of information whenever you interact with our Site through your computer or mobile device. - Any other party where we have obtained your consent or authorization.

Advertising. We may use how you browse to show you ads for LinkSource or our advertising partners that are more relevant to your interests. We may use cookies and other information to provide relevant interest-based advertising to you. Interest-based ads are ads presented to you based on your browsing behavior to provide you with ads more tailored to your interests. These interest-based ads may be presented to you while you are browsing our site or third-party sites not owned or operated by LinkSource.

We belong to ad networks that may use your browsing activity across participating websites to show you interest-based advertisements on those websites Our Site recognizes if your browser sends a "do not track" signal or similar global privacy control mechanism to indicate you do not wish to be tracked or receive interest-based ads. - Detect, prevent, or otherwise address fraud, security, or technical issues; and
- Protect against harm to the rights, property, or safety of LinkSource, our users, customers or the public as required or permitted by law.

Transfer in the Event of Sale or Change of Control. If the ownership of all or substantially all of our business changes or we otherwise transfer assets relating to our business or the Site to a third-party, such as by merger, acquisition, bankruptcy proceeding or otherwise, we may transfer or sell your personal information to the new owner.
